Wild Life

We recently received several reports of coyote packs, bob cats, rattle snakes and raccoon sighting's in the community. Please do not dump any type of food products down the slopes behind your homes. This behavior attracts critters. Pick up fallen fruit from the ground under your fruit trees and dispose of properly. Be cautious when walking the neighborhood. Please make sure you always have a close eye on your children and pets.

Snakes

There have been several rattle snakes sightings in the community, if you find a snake please contact Heartland Fire at 619.441.1621 They answer 24 hours a day and can safely relocate the snake. Be aware of your surroundings.



Recycling Bags

The San Diego County recycling department dropped off recycling bags and information packets for Crown Hills Residents. If you're interested please stop by and pick one up. They are available at the onsite office.

Hyacinth Mailboxes

A few homeowners have expressed concern about the new mailboxes installed on Hyacinth. Homeowners believe they have too much movement. A meeting was scheduled with the vendor. He explained these boxes are top heavy and the movement they make is normal. We also asked our postman and he confirmed what our vendor said. We checked out other locations with these type of mailboxes and they have the same type of movement. The mailboxes have a 12 year warranty.

Pool Etiquette

Please obey the pool rules for everyone's safety and the enjoyment of the community. If you witness anyone jumping the pool fence please report it. This is one of the biggest problems we currently have. Please review the Pool Rules posted on the bulletin board outside the office. Members can be fined and even have their privileges revoked for not following these rules.

Important pool rule reminders:

- ✓ Per SD County regulations—the pool gate must be closed at all times! Do Not prop it open!
- ✓ Do not open the pool gate for anyone! All homeowners have a fob to gain access.
- ✓ All food and beverage must be stored in unbreakable containers (NO GLASS).
- ✓ Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- ✓ Persons who are not toilet-trained may not use the pool or spa. Wader pool is allowed.
- ✓ You must be over 4' 6" tall to be in the spa.

Board Minutes Summary - May 22, 2018

Open Forum

Members asked questions or provided comments on general landscape and maintenance matters, the recently completed asphalt sealing project, and the garage door vote of the members. All questions were answered to the satisfaction of the Members present. Members remained to observe the remainder of the meeting.

Chief Financial Officer's Report

The Operating Account balance is \$23,191. The total Reserve Account balance is \$560,980. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$27,774. Monthly Income was \$66,908 with expenses of \$85,654. Total assets as of 4/30/2018 is \$611,945. A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the financial report as presented for filing pending independent financial review.

Landscape

Upon a motion made, seconded and carried, the Board approved a fire abatement brush clearing proposal from Westwind Landscape for a total cost of \$850.00. Excess mulch left from the tree trimming/removal project will be spread throughout the property by the landscapers one day per week until complete.

Architectural Committee

There were ten (10) new requests received. Ten (10) had an initial review and approval. Four (4) finalized projects were reviewed and approved. Volunteers are needed to fill positions on the committee. Members may sign up in the community office.

Governing Documents Review Committee

The committee consists of Diane Altamirano and Becky Schooler as Co-Chairs, Cathy Santangelo as Board Liaison, Becky Schooler is also the Secretary. Harry Houghton, Bob Massey, Rebecca Ocain, Tom Richardson, and Ann Cole are Members. The committee has submitted a list of recommended amendments to the board for review. The amendments will be forwarded after review to the Attorney for consideration and inclusion in the proposed restated documents.

Unfinished Business

Weir Asphalt has completed the sealing of all of the asphalt streets throughout the community with no major issues or concerns to report.

The spa will be scheduled for resurfacing as well as any code updates needed per county regulations after the summer season is over. There have been no major issues or concerns to report this period.

New Business

The card room carpeting and sections of wall have been damaged from flooding issues in the pool pump room over a period of time. The pump room has been fully repaired and the walls in the card room have been fully repaired. Proposals will be obtained to replace the damaged carpeting. This item will remain on the agenda.

Hot Topics - Mailboxes

The mailboxes serving residents on Hyacinth were recently vandalized. Sprint Postal Services has completed the replacement with higher gauge metal mailboxes to prevent further vandalism. The board reviewed a proposal to replace all of the remaining mailboxes in the community. These mailboxes will be replaced next year per the guidelines stated in the reserve study. Competitive proposals will be obtained.
