The gas pool heater runs from April 1^{st,} thru November 1st. The Solar pool heater is on year round. Please check the bulletin board near the pool for emergency numbers and pool rules.

Simple Steps Save Lives in and around pool & spa

- > Never leave a child unattended in a pool or spa
- > Stay close, be alert and watch children in and around the pool
- > If a child is missing, look for him or her in the pool or spa first
- > Teach children basic water safety
- Keep children away from pool drains, pipes and other openings to avoid entrapments
- > Always watch your child when he or she is in or near water
- > Have a telephone close by when you or your family is using a pool or spa
- > Review safety instructions with all family members
- Learn how to swim and teach your child how to swim
- Learn to perform CPR on children and adults, and update those skills regularly
- Understand the basics of life-saving so you can assist in a pool emergency

Board Minutes Summary - March 25, 2014

Homeowner's Forum

Owner commented she liked the new vegetation installed by the exercise room and mailboxes.

Manager's Report

- > The new pool heater was installed. The pool will be heated by gas beginning April 1st.
- > Copy machine will be installed soon.
- Porter met with the Landscape Committee and Pacific Green. The monthly walk through will be resumed. Better communication procedures should result in a positive return to the association.
- > Casey Myers volunteered to gather well drilling proposals for the HOA. We are very grateful for his help.

President's Report

- > Violation reports are being addressed as quickly as possible.
- > The Landscape Committee will be doing a monthly walk through and will address the turf reduction project.

Treasurer's Report

Soto reported total assets of \$754,930.34 - \$25,412.12 checking, \$709,288.78 reserves, and \$19,729.44 in accounts receivable. Monthly income: \$58,871.97; Monthly expenses \$37,813.17; and a reserve allocation of \$10,750.06 resulting in net operating income: \$10,308.74.

Committee Reports

Architectural – Frank reported work has slowed down. Some homeowners are replacing windows & doors. Fire Safe and Disaster – Porter and the Landscape Company will be walking the perimeter to address possible fire hazards.

Landscaping – Pam reported the committee is very active and this will improve the landscape of the HOA. She thanked all participants.

RV Storage – John reported new lights will arrive next week and will be installed shortly after. The new contracts have been reviewed and will be implemented soon. Things are going well.

Old Business

Clubhouse Area Security – Additional proposals are coming in and will be presented after review.

Pool Heater – New heater installed. Small claims action against Weiser is still to be filed.

Exercise Equipment – New equipment will be delivered shortly.

Tree Trimming – The work has begun on new phase of tree removals.

Night Security – Calico Security raised their fee for a second year . New proposals are being sought.

New Business

USPS Parcel Lockers – Porter reported the USPS has agreed to install new parcel lockers on the property at no cost to the Association.

Re-pavement Plan – The Board reviewed a proposal for the pavement renovation which includes grinding the edges of all roads followed by a 2" overlay. Porter was instructed to solicit proposals for different methods of renovation.
