Annual Meeting Minutes Summary - September 26, 2017

Welcome Introduction

Community Manager Joseph G. Apparito, CCAM welcomed everyone to the meeting and informed all that refreshments are available. All Candidates and the ballot tabulation volunteers were also introduced.

Quorum Establishment and Call to Order

The Community Manager announced the Inspectors of Elections have verified that a quorum has been established with one hundred seventy-three (173) Members represented in person or by secret ballot.

Summary of Events

Candidates running for a Board Seat were allowed to address the Membership at this time. Each of the three Candidates introduced themselves to all present.

Approval of the 2016 Annual Meeting Minutes.

Open Forum - There were 27 Members present for this meeting. Members were free to speak regarding general community related issues. All questions were answered to the full satisfaction of Members present.

Summary of Accomplishments 2016 - 2017

The current Association President Tito Cruz provided a summary of accomplishments achieved during the previous year. Below are a few of the highlights a copy is available upon request in the community office.

- Paid off the road repair loans early
- Upgraded Security and camera system
- Installed handicap ramp to facilitate easy access to the mailboxes via wheel chair
- Repaired a major water leak that caused bank erosion
- Resurfaced the spa floor & ordered new pool furniture
- Upgraded gym equipment
- Formed a Governing Documents committee which recently updated our existing Rules document.
- Several elevated sidewalks were grinded down to avoid trip hazard.
- Our landscape committee along with Westwind continually work to make sure all areas are maintained.
