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Board Minutes Summary - August 22, 2017

Open Forum

Members' present expressed concerns regarding landscape maintenance. The landscapers will be instructed to inspect these areas of concern and address them appropriately. A member suggested installing a motion sensor camera at focal points around the pool/spa area. An update was provided on the well tanks.

Chief Financial Officer's Report

The Operating Account balance is \$47,509.39. The total Reserve Account balance is \$652,370.37. The balance on the asphalt loan is \$181,171.23. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$17,388.10. Monthly Income was \$59,971.66 with expenses of \$54,672.98. Total assets as of July 31, 2017 is \$718,239.61. A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the financial report for period ending July 31, 2017 as presented for filing pending independent financial review. The board voted to payoff the asphalt bank loan prior to the year end as part of the budget process.

- **Architectural Committee** -There were eight (8) new requests during the period 7/25/2017-8/22/2017. Eight (8) requests have been tentatively approved with three (3) requests finalized at this time. Members are reminded that the installation, construction, alteration, addition, modification or reconstruction of any structural improvement in the project which is visible from other lots or the common area shall not be commenced until the plans have been reviewed and approved by the Committee.
- **Landscape Committee** An inspection was conducted on 8/3/2017 with Management, Board Members and the Landscape Supervisor. Concerns were reviewed with the landscapers in great detail and action requested to address areas of concern immediately.
- **Governing Documents Committee** Board Member Cathy Santangelo acting as the Board liaison to the Committee reports that a final draft of amended rules & regulations is complete and submitted to the Board for their review and comment prior to approving distribution. The Board will provide any comments to the committee through Cathy.

Unfinished Business

- **Pool** The Board is reviewing options for replacing some or all of the worn pool furniture. This item will remain on the agenda pending further research. Funding is available through the reserve account for needed replacement.
- 2017 Annual Meeting of Members & Election The Association's Annual Meeting of Members and Election is scheduled for Tuesday, September 26, 2017. The Meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Clubhouse located at 1821 Victoria Park Terrace in Alpine, CA 91901. The purpose of this meeting will be to elect three (3) Members to the Board of Directors. The three (3) Members elected shall serve for terms of two (2) years.

Hot Topics - Asphalt Sealing Proposal

A total of six (6) competitive proposals have been obtained to apply asphalt sealcoat throughout the community. The Board has spent the last several weeks reviewing each of the proposals. After further review and discussion, a motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the proposal from George Weir Asphalt for a cost of \$42,955.00. Announcements will be posted in the newsletter, the website and at each mailbox location. Detailed notices with additional instructions and information will be distributed to each home as the project date nears.
