Rules for Visitor Parking Spaces

Barking Dogs (submitted by a Homeowner)

Why People Should Not Leave Their Dogs Outside for Hours Unsupervised

Though a dog outdoors can relieve itself freely and enjoy fresh air, realize that if a dog continuously barks, then any dog behavior expert will say this means the dog is stressed out and suffering anxiety. The dog isn't happy.

Listen to the barking of dogs left alone outside and the barking of dogs at play. It is two very different kinds of barking. It's normal for dogs to bark occasionally. But when dogs are barking continuously (a few barks every five minutes qualifies as incessant barking), these barks are clearly stress-barks.

There is no excuse for leaving a barking dog outside late at night and/or early in the morning. Let them out to do their 'business' and then bring them in. Don't leave them out all day when you are not home. If you're afraid your dog will soil your house while you're out, 1) Train the dog better or 2) Put the dog in a dog crate in the house or, better yet, Doggy Day Care. Either alternative is better for the dog and the neighborhood than leaving your pet all alone in an empty yard with no human contact and barking all day.

Be considerate of your neighbors AND your dog!
