Voting Information

This month, Homeowners are being asked to vote on two issues. You have received two voting packages in the mail, (1) the change in CC&Rs for water well drilling ballot and (2) the Board of Directors Election ballot. Both issues need a quorum (51% of homeowners returning ballots) to be considered.

The first date to remember is Friday, September 13, 2013

The CCR change to allow well drilling for water is the first ballot to be counted. The deadline to turn in this ballot is 5 p.m. on Friday, September 13, 2013 at the Crown Hills Office. An open meeting is scheduled at 5:01 p.m. to count the ballots. For this change to be passed, 51% of homeowners must approve the change.

Treasurer's Report

Soto reported total assets of \$698,642.01 - \$26,086.69 checking, \$651,558.50 reserves, and \$20,496.82 in accounts receivable. Year-to-date income: \$407,920; Year-to-date expenses \$314,153; Results in net operating income: \$7,936.

Committee Reports

Architectural - Frank reported work is progressing through the neighborhood.

CC&R - Harry waiting for the results of the CC&R change vote.

Fire Safe & Disaster - Marci reported regular meetings are held each month and encouraged attendance.
 Landscape - Pam reported the large trees at the north side of clubhouse are a safety hazard. The committee would like two trees removed.

Water Conservation - Jim reported on water usage and suggested annual cost of water to HOA this year could be approximately \$125,000.

RV Storage - John reported all approved electrical work is complete.

Old Business

Clubhouse Area Security – Schooler reported updates on fob usage, distribution, and monitoring. Well Drilling – Porter encouraged vote in support of the CC&R amendment and well-drilling because the savings to the owners would be substantial.

Exercise Room – The fan was installed and carpet cleaned. The board voted for a bid from PHOAC to paint the room. Four bids were submitted.

New Business

CC&R Amendment – The board voted to appoint the Inspectors of the CC&R Amendment (well drilling) vote: Pam, Kathy, Marci, and Jim. The board agreed to hold an open meeting on Friday, September 13, 2013 at 5:01 p.m. in the clubhouse to count the CC&R Amendment votes.
