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Board Minutes Summary - March 22, 2022

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

- ✓ The Board reviewed the Open Session Meeting Minutes of February 22, 2022. A motion was made, seconded, and carried (MSC) to approve the Minutes as presented.
- ✓ The Board reviewed the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of February 22, 2022, in which the Board reviewed the violation log, the delinquent account log, reviewed homeowner correspondence, and reviewed Association files access guidelines. MSC to approve the minutes as presented.

Financial Report

Period Ending 2/28/2022: The Operating Account balance is \$86,453. The total Reserve Account balance is \$836,768. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$6,908. Monthly Income was \$73,459 with expenses of \$72,967. Total assets are \$930,330. MSC to approve the financial report as presented for filing pending independent financial review.

2021 Independent Financial Review: A draft of the 2021 Independent Financial Review prepared by Sonnenberg & Company, CPA's was provided to the Board for their review. The report provides the reader with an analysis of the Association's financial transactions covering the period from 1/1/2021 – 12/31/2021. MSC to approve the Financial Review as presented for distribution to the membership.

Proposed Special Assessment: Due to the additional brush abatement and tree services required by the Alpine Fire District, the 2022 annual budget for these two line items is under budget by approximately \$42,220. An option for making up the shortfall in funding is to pass a one-time special assessment of \$125 for each homeowner. This item shall remain on the agenda for consideration pending obtaining a legal opinion on any other funding options the Association may have.

Assessment Lien: MSC to approve a notice of intent to lien letter be sent and that a lien be recorded on the property with assessor parcel number 402-423-09-00 in the event payment in full is not received by the deadline imposed in the intent to lien letter.

Committee Reports

Architectural: Committee Chair Michael Beraud reported there were eleven (11) new requests received. Seven (7) received an initial review and approval. Seven (7) were finalize at this time.

Landscape: The Board reviewed an inspection report for this period. All minor maintenance is performed during the regular maintenance schedule. Any major items or issues that come up are put before the board for review and consideration at each posted meeting. No other action was taken at this time.

Unfinished Business

County Health Update: There are no new county updates for this period.

Clubhouse HVAC Replacement: The Board has spent the past months reviewing several competitive proposals to replace three (3) cooling and heating systems within the community building. After further review and discussion, MSC to approve the proposal from Bailey Air Conditioning & Heating for a total cost of \$28,300.

Brow Ditch Repair/Replace: DB Engineering has completed filling a sink hole with approximately 70 yards of slurry concrete and replaced the damaged brow ditch on the common sloped area off of Hyacinth. DB also replaced a damaged brow ditch on the common sloped area off of Lobelia. STP Masonry will soon schedule replacement of approximately 750 lineal feet of damaged brow ditch in the park area between Larkspur and Star Thistle and to replace approximately 120 lineal feet of damaged brow ditch coming from the clubhouse parking area down to Victoria Park Terrace. Further updates are provided at each meeting.

New Business

Fire Prevention Presentation: Kelly Berkompas with Brand Guard Vents was not able to attend due to illness. This will remain on the agenda for the next meeting.

Homeowners Open Forum Any questions were answered to the satisfaction of the Members present.
