### Important CC&R'S Rule Reminders Section 10.6 -Vehicles and Parking Restrictions:

Due to an increase in parking violations in the community, we are asking residents to review Crown Hills Parking Rules: Some are listed below.

- \* **Commercial Vehicles** can only be parked in your garage. Not your driveways, guest parking or streets.
- \* This rule applies to **all** Residents: **Street Parking** is permitted only for *loading* and *unloading*. Your guests are encourage to park in the guests parking areas. However, they can park in your driveway or in the immediate vicinity or your home *only*. Except from 12:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. where vehicles are subject to tow at owners expense.
- \* Designated parking areas are your garage and your driveway. Not on pavers, rocks, or grass, artificial grass or anywhere not considered a designated parking area.
- Do not park immediately opposite a vehicle on the street. This practice makes it difficult for emergency vehicles to get through our neighborhood.

If you don't want a violation letter in your mailbox make sure to follow the above rules listed & all parking rules in your CC&R'S Section 10.6.

# Board Zoom Meeting Summary - December 01, 2020

#### Presidents Message on page 1

### Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

**Open Session** The Board reviewed the Open Session Meeting Minutes of October 27, 2020. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the Minutes as presented.

**Executive Session** The Board reviewed the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of October 27, 2020 in which the Board reviewed the violation log, the delinquent account log, reviewed homeowner correspondence and held due process violation hearings. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the Minutes as presented.

#### **Financial Report**

- **Period Ending 10/31/2020:** The Operating Account balance is \$85,983. The total Reserve Account balance is \$730,900. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$7,774. Monthly Income was \$70,441 with expenses of \$59,997. Total assets are \$824,922. A motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the financial report as presented for filing pending independent financial review
- **CD Investments Review:** The Board was provided an updated list of current CDs managed by Merrill Lynch for their review. No other action was needed at this time.
- **2020 Financial Review Proposal:** The Board reviewed proposals to perform the 2020 Financial Review and prepare the 2020 Federal and State Income Tax Returns. After further review, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to approve the proposal from Sonnenberg & Company, CPA's for a cost of \$1,250.

#### **Committee Reports**

- Architectural: Committee Chair Mike Wilmers was present and provided a report for this period. There were eleven (11) new requests received. Nine (9) had an initial review and approval. Eight (8) were finalized at this time. The Committee expressed thanks to the many residents that follow the community guidelines when making any exterior changes.
- **Landscape:** The Board reviewed an inspection report for this period. All minor maintenance is performed during the regular maintenance schedule. Any major items or issues that come up are put before the board for review and consideration at each posted meeting. No other action was taken or needed at this time.



#### **Unfinished Business**

**County Health Update:** The Board discussed new updates received from the state and county. As meaningful updates are received, the board will review and call a meeting and alert the Membership.

#### **New Business**

There was no new business to discuss this period.

#### Homeowners Open Forum

Members were free to speak on any matter of interest to the Community. Each person was provided three minutes to speak. Members were present to comment on Halloween guidelines and landscape matters, and minor maintenance matters.
