It is that time of the year again for weeds to be cut at a height of no higher than 6". Please keep and maintain growth closer to the home short and clear. Remember we are still in the education time period about removing the first 5' of the items within the perimeter of the home. This will be strictly enforced January 2023. Insurance Companies are enforcing now and issuing notice of non-renewals. Let us set the example of how fire safe Alpine is and showcase our Firewise presence. 2022 Tree Maintenance

Tree maintenance continues throughout the community for approximately three more weeks. We appreciate your continued patience with the noise.

Weed Abatement Update

We want to thank you for your patience while our Landscape crew is tackling the weeds on the community slopes. All areas will be taken care of. If the landscape crew has not made it to your section, they will very soon.

Dogs Off Leash

We are still having a problem with residents walking their dogs without a leash. This is specially a problem in the clubhouse area. Dogs must remain on a leash at all times while walking on common areas. You must follow this rule to avoid receiving a violation letter. Remember the clubhouse area is under video surveillance 24/7. Thank you to all residents who follow this and all community rules.

Snakes

We have received several reports of rattle snake sightings in different areas of the community. Be aware of your surroundings and make sure you advise your children to be careful. If you find a rattlesnake, contact **Heartland Fire at 619.441.1621**. They answer 24 hours a day and can safely relocate the snake.

Architectural Changes

Please remember to get approval prior to making any changes to the outside of your property's appearance. Changes include removing grass for xeriscape, building a shed, adding a gate, placing pavers, painting or any other change. Members are permitted to maintain existing improvements but **any deviations** to those improvements require approval prior to the change.

Street & Guest Parking

Please be advised street parking is *not allowed* between the hours of 12 am and 5 am. **This is strictly enforced**. Vehicles are subject to tow at homeowners expense. Guest parking **is for guests only**. MT Security monitors all guest parking areas. If you do not have a parking permit to be parked longer than the 96 hour rule, you will be towed. Please note, moving your vehicle from one guest parking space to another or alternating your personal vehicles will not avoid towing. **Refer to CC&Rs Section 11.5 Vehicle & Parking Restrictions**.

Speed Racers

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Board Minutes Summary - April 26, 2022

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

- ✓ The Board reviewed the Open Session Meeting Minutes of March 22, 2022. A motion was made, seconded, and carried (MSC) to approve the Minutes as presented.
- ✓ The Board reviewed the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of March 22, 2022, in which the Board reviewed the violation log, the delinquent account log, reviewed homeowner correspondence.
- ✓ The Board discussed a proposed special assessment and held a due process violation hearing. MSC to approve the minutes as presented.

Financial Report

Period Ending 3/31/2022: The Operating Account balance is \$50,717. The total Reserve Account balance is \$797,109. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$6,749. Monthly Income was \$74,353 with expenses of \$112,150. Total assets are \$854,777. MSC to approve the financial report as presented for filing pending independent financial review.

Proposed Special Assessment: Due to the additional brush abatement and tree services required by the Alpine Fire District, the 2022 annual budget for these two line items is under budget by approximately \$42,220. An option for making up the shortfall in funding is to pass a one-time special assessment of \$125 for each homeowner. MSC to approve the one-time special assessment of \$125 per owner to be paid by August 1, 2022. More detailed information to be mailed to homeowners.

Committee Reports

Architectural: Committee Chair Michael Beraud was present and provided a report for this period. There were ten (10) new requests received. Eight (8) received an initial review and approval. Two (2) are pending. Eight (8) were finalized at this time.

Landscape: The Board reviewed an inspection report for this period. All minor maintenance is performed during the regular maintenance schedule. Any major items or issues that come up are put before the board for review and consideration at each posted meeting. No other action was taken at this time.

Unfinished Business

County Health Update: There are no new county updates for this period.

Clubhouse HVAC Replacement: Bailey Heating & Air Conditioning is scheduled to begin the replacement of three (3) cooling and heating systems within the community building on 4/27 and be complete on 4/29.

Brow Ditch Repair/Replace: DB Engineering has completed filling a sink hole with approximately 70 yards of slurry concrete and replaced the damaged brow ditch on the common sloped area off of Hyacinth. DB also replaced a damaged brow ditch on the common sloped area off of Lobelia. STP Masonry is in process of replacing approximately 750 linear feet of damaged brow ditch in the park area between Larkspur and Star Thistle and to replace approximately 120 linear feet of damaged brow ditch from the clubhouse parking area down to Victoria Park Terrace. Brow ditches throughout the community will continue to be repaired/replaced as funding is made available.

New Business

Fire Prevention Presentation: Kelly Berkompas with Brand Guard Vents and Bonnie Burchill of Sunrise Power Link were present to discuss fire mitigation in and around the community and ways homeowners can help to protect their properties.

2022 Inspector of Election Appointment: MSC to appoint Becky Schooler as the Inspector of Election for the Annual Meeting & Election scheduled on 9/27/2022 contingent on receiving more nomination forms than open board positions. There are two (2) board seats up for election with a term of two (2) years. MSC for the following action: Per CA Civil Code, if, at the close of the time period for making nominations, there are the same number or fewer qualified candidates as there are board positions to be filled, the Board will seat the qualified candidates by acclimation without balloting.

Homeowners Open Forum Members asked questions regarding the proposed special assessment. Any questions were answered to the satisfaction of the Members present.
