Annual Meeting Minutes Summary 8/28/2021

Welcome Introduction - Cathy Santangelo, Board President, welcomed everyone to the Annual meeting and thanked them for voting & being present. Cathy asked the Inspector of Elections, Becky Schooler, to confirm quorum was met.

Quorum Establishment and Call to Order The Inspector of Elections announced that a quorum was met with 127 ballots received. The ballot tabulation volunteers were then instructed to open and tabulate all ballots.

President's Report The current Association President, Cathy Santangelo, provided a statement to the Membership. All Board Members, and Committee Members were thanked for all of the time and efforts volunteering to serve the community and make Crown Hills the community it is. Management was also thanked for their commitment to the community. All members present acknowledged Cathy for all of her time and efforts as well.

Board Minutes Summary - September 28, 2021

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

- ✓ The Board reviewed the Open Session Meeting Minutes of August 24, 2021. A motion was made, seconded, and carried (MSC) to approve the Minutes as presented.
- The Board reviewed the Executive Session Meeting Minutes of August 24, 2021 in which the Board reviewed the violation log, the delinquent account log, reviewed homeowner correspondence, and held due process violation hearings. MSC to approve the minutes as presented.

Financial Report

Period Ending 8/31/2021: The Operating Account balance is \$82,600. The total Reserve Account balance is \$758,438. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$5,456. Monthly Income was \$68,298 with expenses of \$84,386. Total assets are \$846,695. MSC to approve the financial report as presented for filing pending independent financial review.

The CFO also presented a report on expenses and costs effecting the Association and the monthly assessment. All Members present showed appreciation for this additional information.

Committee Reports

Architectural: Committee Chair Mike Wilmers was not present but provided a report for this period. There were ten (10) new requests received. Eight (8) received an initial review and approval. None were finalized at this time.

Landscape: The Board reviewed an inspection report for this period.

- The Board reviewed a proposal from Westwind to remove two pine trees that had been causing some issues with an owners rear patio. The trees are recommended for removal to stop any further issues. MSC to approve the proposal as presented for a cost of \$1,400.
- The Board is in process of obtaining competitive proposals for brush abatement in specific areas of the community per a request from the Alpine Fire Marshall. This item shall remain on the agenda.

Pool/Spa: All equipment is functioning well and no other issues to report this period.

Unfinished Business

County Health Update: No updates at this time.

- **Tennis Court Maintenance/Repair:** Ferandell Tennis Courts, Inc. is tentatively scheduled to resurface the tennis courts beginning October 4th and to replace the old and damaged wind screens on both courts. A new pickleball net system will also be installed during this project.
- New Business There is no new business to report for this period.

Homeowners Open Forum - Members were free to speak on any matter of interest to the Community.

Adjournment - With no other business to come before the Meeting, MSC to adjourn at 6:28 p.m.

Annual meeting minutes continued:

Open Forum There were approximately 27 Members present for this meeting. The Board answered all questions to the full satisfaction of all members present.

Approval of the 2020 Annual Meeting Minutes - The minutes approved as submitted.
