When I walk around our community, I see what appears to be an early Spring. Residents doing yard work, the trees starting to bloom and the weather is beautiful. This is the time of the year when many of our major projects will begin.

The Board voted to start the pool heater early so the pool will be warm prior to the Spring break. We anticipate to keep the temperature between 75 and 80 degrees. Many of you have asked for lighting around the mailboxes. The Board approved adding lights to the Clubhouse parking lot which will illuminate the mailbox area. Work will begin soon so the lights can be finished before the repaving takes place. In addition to the lights, the dance floor inside will be replaced with a beautiful new multi-use flooring.

Work on the roads will begin around May 9th. In this edition and future editions of the Newsletter specific instructions will be given along with the paving schedule. It is critical that EVERYONE must follow the directions of our contractor so we can complete the job as soon as possible. One of the changes that will be necessary is rerouting the Alpine School District busses. Information will be forthcoming as to where the route will be moved for pickup and drop off.

This form is available in the office. Congratulations to Hilde Hinchcliff who was recently selected to Chair the greater Alpine Floral and Gardening Club. if you are interested in this group, please give your contact information to Candace who will see that Hilde receives it.

Lastly, I met with Dianne Jacobs, after the Alpine Revitalization Committee in January. We discussed the need to have a red curb on Victoria Park Terrace and Larkspur Drive. Supervisor Jacobs said she thought this was a good idea and assured me that she would take my request to the correct department that handles these requests. I believe we will have a safety zone in a few months. On behalf of the Board I want to personally say Thank You to those individuals who have come forward to volunteer to serve on the various committees here in Crown Hills. We still need more help to make our community "The Jewel of Alpine". One way you can get involved is to attend our monthly Homeowners Meetings. The new starting time of the Open Session is 6:30 p.m.

Asphalt Project

Board Minutes Summary - February 23, 2016

President's Report

The Association President provided a report on current activities around the community. The clubhouse roof has been repaired, guest parking rules are being enforced more strongly and asphalt work will be scheduled soon.

Chief Financial Officer's Report

The Board reviewed the Financial Report for period ending 1/31/2016. The Operating Account balance is \$95,819.12, the Reserve Account balance is \$888,020.13 and the Accounts Receivable balance is \$9,727.96 Pre-paid Income totaled \$24,379.37. Monthly Income was \$58,396.00 with expenses of \$40,989.00 for a net of \$17,407.00. Total assets as of 1/31/2016 is \$967,259.59.

Committee Reports

Architectural – 19 new requests have been approved this period. 17 prior approvals were completed this period.

Landscape – Pacific Green Landscape is now conducting monthly walkthroughs and providing reports of issues to address. The Board has approved Western Tree Service to remove and prune several trees along Victoria Park Terrace and Gentian Way.

Water Usage – Jim Hook provided a brief report for this period to all members present.

Unfinished Business

Community Asphalt Repair/Replacement Update - Expected to begin in early May, weather permitting Clubhouse Parking Lot Lighting Proposals - The Board approved the installation of two (2) 4-head parking lot pole lights in the Clubhouse parking area to better illuminate the parking and mailbox areas.

Monitoring Camera System - The Board approved Security 101 to install a new camera system that will be more advanced technology than the current system and will be under a 5 year warranty.

New Business

Board Meeting Times - The start time is now 6:30 p.m. for Open Session beginning on 3/22/2016. **Clubhouse/Office Flooring Replacement** - The flooring has been approved and will be replaced by Village Carpets and Flooring in the near future.

2016 Reserve Expenditure Review - The Board has been reviewing the recommended component replacements for 2016 per the recently completed reserve study to determine the funding availability for several needed projects. Each item will be inspected to determine if replacement is needed now or if replacement can be pushed back another year. Replacement will be scheduled if needed.

Pool Heater Start Date - The Board reviewed and discussed when the pool heater shall be turned on this year. After further discussion the Board has instructed that the pool heater shall be turned on and set at 80 degrees effective 3/1/2016. Management will verify that the solar equipment is operating properly.
