NO Smoking

There is absolutely no smoking allowed near the Clubhouse, in the pool area or tennis courts. If you or your guest wish to smoke, please do so away from these areas and properly extinguish and dispose of your trash. There are no ash trays on the property.

A Message From Alpine Fire

Alpine Fire Protection District asks for all home owners to test all smoke alarms monthly. Press the "test button" hold it until the unit goes off then let go. Allow the alarms to ring, check that the outside flasher is operating correctly. If the smoke alarm is over 10 years old it is time to replace them with new units. All new smoke alarms that are manufactured today include a built in 10 year battery if supplied by the house power. NO NEED TO REPLACE BATTERY.

A/C Condensation Line

There are easy ways you can prevent a clog and even remove one once it has occurred. Check your condensation line regularly for clogs to keep you're A/C in good repair while we all get through the heat.

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Board Meeting Minutes Summary - June 21, 2016

President's Report - Please see front page

Chief Financial Officer's Report - The Operating Account balance is \$88,044.40. The Reserve Account balance is \$1,022,339.40. The Accounts Receivable balance is \$6,246.00. Pre-paid Income totaled \$25,637.82. Monthly Income was \$58,788.00 with expenses of \$42,687.00 for a net of \$16,101.00. Total assets as of 5/31/2016 is \$1,117,602.00 which includes the funded bank asphalt loan.

Committee Reports

Architectural – The committee has approved 7 new requests with 5 finalized this period. They are working on amendments to the Architectural Guidelines which will be submitted to the Board for Review.

Landscape – Pacific Green Landscapes Contract will end on 6/30/2016. Westwind Landscape will begin landscape services on 7/1/2016. Any remaining open ended action items will be completed by Westwind. The Board reviewed a proposal from Plant-Tek, Inc. to treat 129 Canary Pines for Borer Beatles and Tip Moth control. This item has been tabled pending obtaining competitive proposals.

Unfinished Business

Community Asphalt Repair/Replacement Update - The asphalt repair/replace project should be completed by 6/25/2016. RV's may begin moving back into the RV lot on 6/25/2016. A special thanks to Tom Dyke for allowing the use of his lot for RV storage during this project. The Board has been satisfied with the work performance of George Weir Asphalt to date. The benefits to the Association for the review, inspections and oversight of the asphalt project by Monty Wilde of Asphalt Management & Contracting has been invaluable and performed to the full satisfaction of the Board.

RV Access Fob System - The Board reviewed a proposal from Security 101 to correct wireless connection issues at the RV location. This item has been tabled pending obtaining competitive proposals.

New Business

2016 Annual Meeting of the Members & Election - The Association's Annual Meeting of Members and Election is scheduled for Tuesday September 27, 2016. The meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Clubhouse located at 1821 Victoria Park Terrace in Alpine, CA 91901. Two (2) Board Seats are up for election, the two (2) Candidates receiving the highest number of votes will each serve a two (2) year term. A quorum consisting of at least 50% of the Members (167) must be represented in person or by secret ballot for the meeting and election to take place. The Community Management Company shall act as Inspector of Election with assistance from volunteer Members. Candidate Forms will be distributed the week of 6/27/2016.

Pool/Spa Fencing - The Board is considering upgrading the fencing around the pool area to better secure from trespassing. This item will remain on the agenda as competing proposals are received for review.

Hot Topic - Landscaping

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Many residents are either replacing their yards with rocks or just letting them turn to dirt. Please keep your property nice, get approval before changing your landscaping. Please see your CC&R's for more details.

Section 7.2 (b) Each Owner shall endeavor to install drought resistant landscaping, primarily of ☆ living plants, trees and shrubs, and water conserving irrigation systems.

★ Section 11.15 Maintenance By Owner. The Owner of each Lot shall maintain his Lot, including the ★ improvements which are a part thereof, in a clean and attractive condition. Without limiting the generality 🖈 of the foregoing, the Owner of each Lot shall: (a) keep his Lot free from rubbish, litter and noxious 🔯 weeds, (b) maintain, cultivate and keep in good condition and repair, shrubs, trees, grass, lawns, plantings and other landscaping located or from time to time placed upon his Lot, (c) trim and restrain all trees, shrubs or plantings of any kind so that they shall not be allowed to overhang or otherwise encroach upon, above or below any sidewalk or street, unless prior approval of the Architectural Committee is obtained, (d) maintain in good condition and repair and adequately painted or otherwise finished all improvements which are from time to time a part of his Lot, and (e) maintain all paved surfaces and keep them clean, reasonably dry and free of oil and other extraneous matter.
